- **Artworks due** at the Hearst Church on May 1, 2018, 12 to 2 pm.
Judging of artworks by:
TBD - Fine Arts & Photography
TBD - Crafts
- **Opening reception** is at 4:30-6:30pm on Friday, May 4, 2018.
 - Set up at 3 pm

General Submission Requirements:

- \$5.00 entry fee per member
- All submissions (fine arts, photography, and crafts) must have two copies of the GCAG label; one is to be securely attached to the object, and one will be publically displayed
 - A sheet of labels is on the next page of these guidelines (also available to download from our website, <http://gcag.org/downloads.html>)
 - Without proper identification, the item will not be included in the show
 - Remember to write-in the category you choose for your artwork

Submissions Guidelines, Fine Arts:

- Quantity: No more than 3 images per artist, per category
- Size: Overall size shall not exceed 48" in either direction
- Character: Family appropriate, "G-rated"
- Conventional framing; ready to hang with wire approximately 2" below top of frame
 - Unframed, clips, or cardboard-backed canvas panels will be rejected
 - Unframed gallery wraps will have to be ready to hang with wire 2" below the top of the frame

Submissions Guidelines, Crafts:

- Quantity: No more than 5 pieces per artist per category
 - Follow display practices appropriate for each craft
 - Character: Family appropriate, "G-rated"

Reception:

- First half of membership (alphabetically) brings refreshments, plus anyone else who wishes to.
- Hearty refreshments are requested along with sweets

- Punch, coffee, and serving supplies will be supplied by GCAG
- At the April meeting, please sign up for what you expect to bring

Categories & Ribbons:

- Three "Best of Show"
 - Fine Arts
 - Photography
 - Crafts
- Each major category will have
 - First, Second, and Third Place ribbons
 - Honorable Mention ribbons where appropriate
- **Categories for Fine Arts** as follows:
 - Acrylic
 - Mixed Media
 - Oil
 - Pastel
 - Drawing (graphite, pen & ink, colored pencil, charcoal)
 - Watercolor/Tempera/Water-Based Media, but not acrylic
 - 3-D Works/Sculpture
- **Categories for Photography** as follows:
 - Features Digital Manipulation
 - Landscape
 - Still Life
 - Wildlife
- **Categories for Crafts** as follows (alphabetical order)
 - Fiber Arts (constructed pieces, silk painting)
 - Glass Works
 - Jewelry
 - Leather Work
 - Mixed Media
 - Needlework (crochet, knitting, etc.)
 - Pottery & Ceramics
 - Woodcraft

See attached **Label Sheet:**

- The left side is to identify your "category" of artwork, and it is to be attached to the backside of the piece.
- Secure the right side to the front of the piece, and it will be on public display during the show.
- For the judging, all identification will be concealed.
